



## Detailed Tour Itinerary

### Biblical Zionists 60th Diamond Anniversary Tour

Nov 7th - 18th 2008

This tour is led and guided by the Holy One of Israel and we are subject to His divine intervention and appointed times.



#### Day 1: Welcome to Israel! Friday 11/07/08

Arrival in Ben Gurion Airport, near Tel Aviv. Transfer Mt. Zion hotel in Jerusalem. You will register in the lobby and then we'll enjoy a private Shabbat service/ dinner at a nearby location with a view of the Old City walls.

#### Day 2: Shabbat in Jerusalem Saturday 11/08/08

Shabbat will be a time of prayer, Torah study and fellowship. At the hotel, we'll have a private facility where we are free to come in and out throughout the day. You can walk to the City of the great King.

Spend your Shabbat with HaShem and His people.

#### Day 3: Bet El- Shilo- Ariel- Biblical Zionist Offices Sunday 11/09/08

We begin our experience with a deeper understanding of what exists in what some refer to as the "disputed territories" of the beautiful Shomron. We'll see where Jacob laid his head on a rock and saw the angels ascending and descending from Hashamim. In Shilo we'll visit where the ancient Mishkan stood. Next stop will be the Biblical Zionist offices in Shaar Benjamin where the TV studio is available for Biblical teachings, current events interviews with leaders in the Land and promotion of everything surrounding Biblical Zionism.

Lunch will be at the famous Shiffon Restaurant located close to the offices where residents travel for miles to buy breads and homemade food. Late afternoon arrival in Jerusalem to shop on Ben Yehuda St, pray at the Wall, or return to the hotel. The evening will be dinner at the hotel and afterwards will be a time of worship and teaching.



#### Day 4: Gush Katif Refugees in Ein Zurim- Amatzia- Organic Farm in Negev Monday 11/10/08

Many of you know the devastation that the people of Gush Katif experienced in August of 2005 when The Nation's "Roadmap" destroyed their homes, communities and for some, their families. Frontline Israel was there during the expulsion and has had the divine opportunity to serve the people of Gush Katif. For 3 1/2 years they have heard about you and now they want to meet you and thank you

and extend opportunities to build new communities with them. You'll visit just 2 of the many refugee villages around the country. Led by their top Engineers and Planners, we'll go to the sites where they have been given hundreds of acres of land to build their new communities. They will describe first hand about the opportunities to invest in hospitals, R&D Centers, Hi Tech and Agriculture.

Lunch in Beer Sheva with many kinds of restaurants to choose from. Next you'll meet an amazing man who was first expelled from Yamit in the Siani in the 1980's and then expelled again from Gush Katif 3 + years ago. Since then he's planted every kind of organic fruit and vegetable on about 100 acres in the Negev. Through great adversity and all alone, he believed in his G-d to supply all of the harvests. You'll learn how you can participate in these amazing harvests and talk about ideas for partnership. In the evening we'll dine and retire at a 5 star hotel at the Dead Sea (Isrotel Hotel).



### **Day 5: Dead Sea- Masada-Ein Gedi Tuesday 11/11/08**

You'll feel refreshed after a night at a 5 star hotel and after breakfast you can go to the mineral baths, hire a massage, stroll through the shops or soak in the sea. There will be private jeep tours available (early in the morning). There also be a tour available to Masada and Ein Gedi. After a full day we'll travel 1 ½ hours back to Jerusalem and check in again to the Mt. Zion Hotel. We'll have dinner at the hotel together and prepare for an eventful day on Wednesday at the Prime Ministers conference.



### **Day 6: Jerusalem- Prime Minister's Conference Weds 11/12/08**

The day will begin early to arrive at the Conference center in Jerusalem where business people, dignitaries, and international Government Leaders are assembling to solidify business in Israel. The current Israeli Prime Minister, Ministers of the Knesset and Israeli business owners will host you and provide many options for investment with successful businesses. You will choose from the list of parallel conferences to attend the one of most interest to you. This will educate you on how to start companies in Israel and give you insight to the latest technologies, inventions and manufacturing tools.

### **Day 7: Menachem Begin Center- Knesset- World Likud Event Thurs 11/13/08**

We start this day with a visit to the Menachem Begin Heritage Center to learn about the life of Begin. You'll walk through a multimedia presentation of re-enacted moments in Begin's powerful life. The experience will give you insight and understanding to the cost that was paid for the birth of the State of Israel and the history of

the Likud Party. Begin was first introduced to Israeli military strategy while he was a youth in Poland and became a leader of the Betar movement.

The center is located very close to the famous German Colony where there are a variety of restaurants that you can choose from for your lunch. After lunch we'll take a tour of the Knesset and visit with several Ministers of the Knesset. Dinner will be at the Mt. Zion hotel. The evening will be free to fellowship, shop or tour Jerusalem.

### **Day 8: Golan- Druze Villages- Mt. Carmel-Tsfat Friday 11/14/08**

After breakfast we'll drive up to the north to visit Dalyat/ Carmel where former Knesset Member Ayoob Kara will host us for the day. We'll meet with the Mayor of the city and have a formal invitation to work together with the leaders of the City in development projects and new opportunities. We'll tour the Military Academy of the Druze and you will learn how we are working together.

\*\*The Druze community in Israel is officially recognized as a separate religious entity with its own courts (with jurisdiction in matters of personal status - marriage, divorce, maintenance and adoption) and spiritual leadership. Their culture is distinct and their language is Arabic but they opted against mainstream Arab nationalism in 1948 and have since served in the Israel Defense Forces and the Border Police. Their dedication to Israel and the Jewish people is unequalled in Israel today. They serve the one true G-d and they are not Muslim- they are the descendants of Jethro who advised Moses. The Druze have lived in Israel for over 1000 years and have received thousands

We will eat authentic Kosher Druze cuisine and learn about their history. (This lunch will be an extra \$17 per person). Before Shabbat comes in we'll get settled into our quarters up in the mountains of Tsfat at the Ruth Rimonim Hotel. We'll gather to give thanks for an amazing week, break bread, and eat Shabbat dinner.



### **Day 9: Shabbat in the Golan/ Galilee Saturday 11/15/08**

After breakfast at the hotel you can either stay at the hotel where we'll have a room for prayer, worship or Torah teaching or our tour buses will take you to explore the Banyas Waterfalls or check out the Galilee. After Shabbat we'll go to the hotel and have a time of wine tasting to enjoy the variety of Israeli wines before dinner.



### **Day 10: Bet Shean Sites Sunday 11/16/08**

In the morning we'll travel along the beautiful Sea of Galilee to Beit Shean. Because of its fertility and convenient location, the Beit Shean Valley has been inhabited since antiquity. The earliest occupation dates back to early biblical times. The valley is a part of the Jordan valley, and stretches in a soft slope towards the Jordan, and in the East the Jezreel Valley links with it. The valley has been on the trade route to the east since

the earliest times and Beit Shean was just in the right place to control it. It also has a perennial spring, the Harod River. We'll stop for lunch along the way and then back to Mt Zion Hotel to prepare for the big GALA evening event for the inauguration of the Worldwide Biblical Zionist Organization. The attire will be coat and tie and for women -evening cocktail attire.



### **Day11: Hevron -Jerusalem Monday 11/17/08**

In the morning we'll join together to watch a documentary with the Producer/ Director about Hevron. Afterwards we'll travel to Hevron and visit Ruth and Jesse's burial sites and of course see the Machpela that Abraham bought as a burial site for his family.

You will learn about the importance of Hevron in the scriptures and how the bold presence of 500 Jewish families protects the lives of all of Israel. After dinner, We'll gather for our last night in Jerusalem together and conclude with music and guest speakers.



### **Day11: Optional Tour to Tel Aviv / Jaffa- Ben Gurion Tues 11/18/08**

In the morning we'll end the tour. You can choose our optional tour to Jaffa/ Tel Aviv.

If your flight leaves late in the evening we can plan a full day and bring you to the airport around 8:30pm.

**Package Does Not Include:** Tips and lunches are not a part of the package price. The PM Conference is an extra \$100 per person. Transportation to the hotel to & from the airport (Only for arrivals on the 7th and pre-arranged) and extra days at the hotel are not included.

**WEATHER:** November daytime temperatures for most of Israel will be in the 60s. Jerusalem and the Golan can drop to the 50s or 40s. Evenings in Jerusalem or the Golan can be quite cool. The Negev and Dead Sea will be approximately 10 degrees warmer. There are occasional rain showers throughout the country, but nothing torrential.

**ATTIRE:** When you go to The Wall in Jerusalem, Shomron, Hevron or The Old City you will need to wear "appropriate" clothing. Long Pants for men - no shorts, even in hot weather and a Kippa (or hat) for visits to Hevron and the Wall. Women, bring something to keep your shoulders covered if you're wearing sleeveless shirts. Skirts are not required.

**Money Change:** When you arrive to the Mt. Zion Hotel on the 7th to register, there will be a money changer to help with immediate needs. There will be opportunities for you to change money throughout the tour either in the Old City or Ben Yehuda St. in Jerusalem. Credit cards (Master Card and Visa) are widely accepted and you can also withdrawl money from the ATM's (in English).

**Transport from Airport:** For those that are arriving on the day of the tour Nov 7th we have pre-arranged transportation to the hotel. For the participants that will arrive before the 7th, you can take a taxi to the hotel or a Shiroot. Both are available as you exit the airport.
